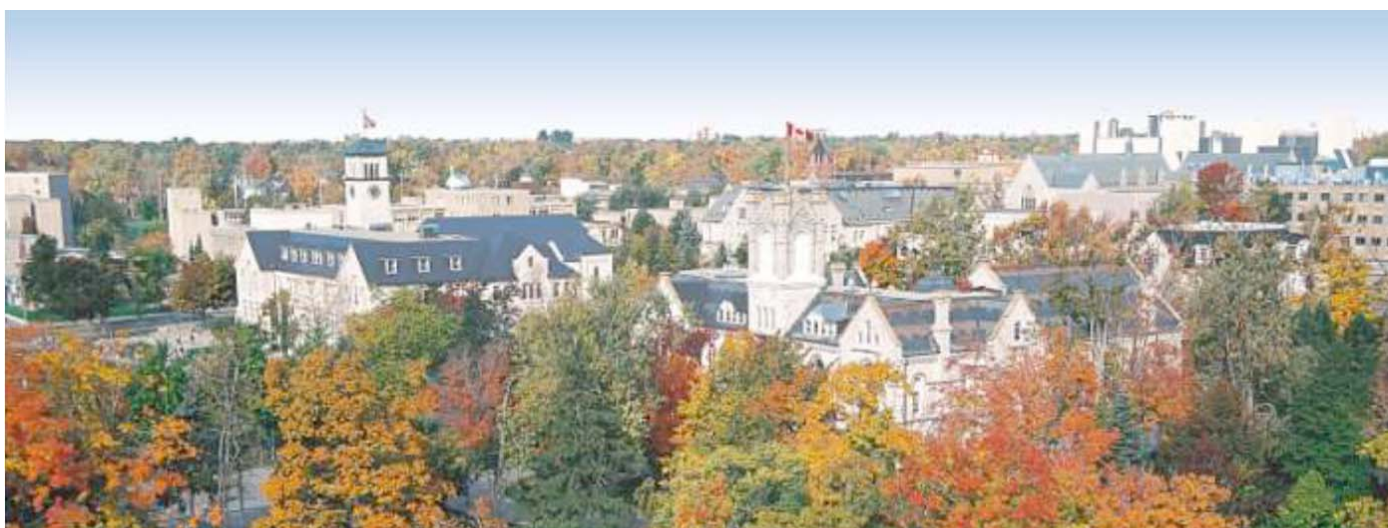

# English for Academic Purposes

## Program Details

- Length: 12 weeks per level
- Integrated curriculum for all four language skills (Reading, Writing, Listening, and Speaking)
- 6 Levels: Beginner, Elementary, Intermediate I, Intermediate II, Advanced, University Preparation
- 22.5 hours per week of language instruction and practice
- Average class size: 15 students
- Session dates\*: Fall (Sept – Dec), Winter (Jan – Apr), Spring/Summer (May – Aug)



# Business Internship Program

The Business Internship Program (BIP) allows you to study English and gain work experience in Canada at the same time. We work with qualified employers so that you get the best experience possible. The primary purpose of the BIP is language education, not professional experience.



## Program Details

- Length: 13 weeks
  - Average class size: 15 students
  - Receive a letter of reference from your Canadian employer upon completion
  - Session dates\*: Fall (Sept – Dec), Winter (Jan – Apr), Spring/Summer (May – Aug)

## Curriculum

- 1<sup>st</sup> 4-week period in classroom (22.5 hours/week)
- 2<sup>nd</sup> 4-week period: ½ days in-class (15 hours/week) & ½ days in work placement
- 3<sup>rd</sup> 4-week period: full days in work placement
- Final week of program: return to classroom

## Requirements

- New Students: minimum TOEFL score of 71 iBT (530 PBT/197 CBT) or 670 TOEIC
- Current QSoE EAP students: must have high standing in English 140 or English 150
- Home country work experience preferred
- Must have both Study and Work permits to enter this program

# English Language & Culture Program

## Program Details

- Length: 4 weeks
- Integrated skills curriculum emphasizing aural/oral skills and Canadian cultural and social content
- 18 hours of classroom instruction plus 2 hours of guided outings per week
- The theme, Kingston Past & Present will carry through the school trips and guided excursions
- Average class size: 15 students
- Upon arrival a placement test will be administered and students will be placed according to their level of language proficiency
- Session dates\*: August

## Accommodation

The School can help with two types of accommodation for students: Residence or placement with a Homestay family.

Both of these types of accommodation have limited availability, so students should apply early in order to obtain their preferred choice of accommodation.

- Queen's University Residence
- Placement with a local Homestay host/family
